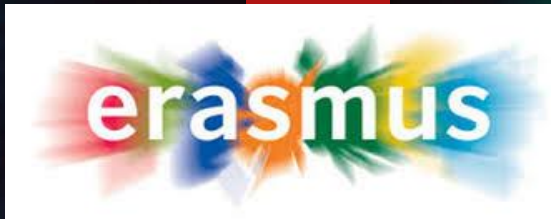

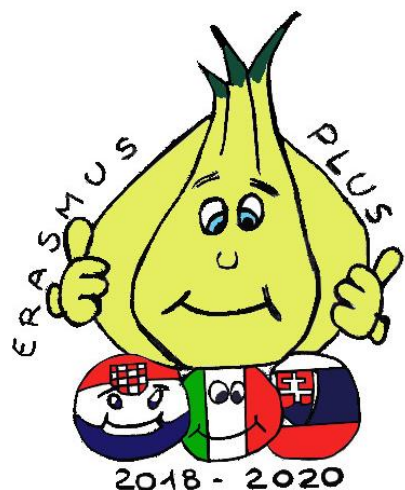

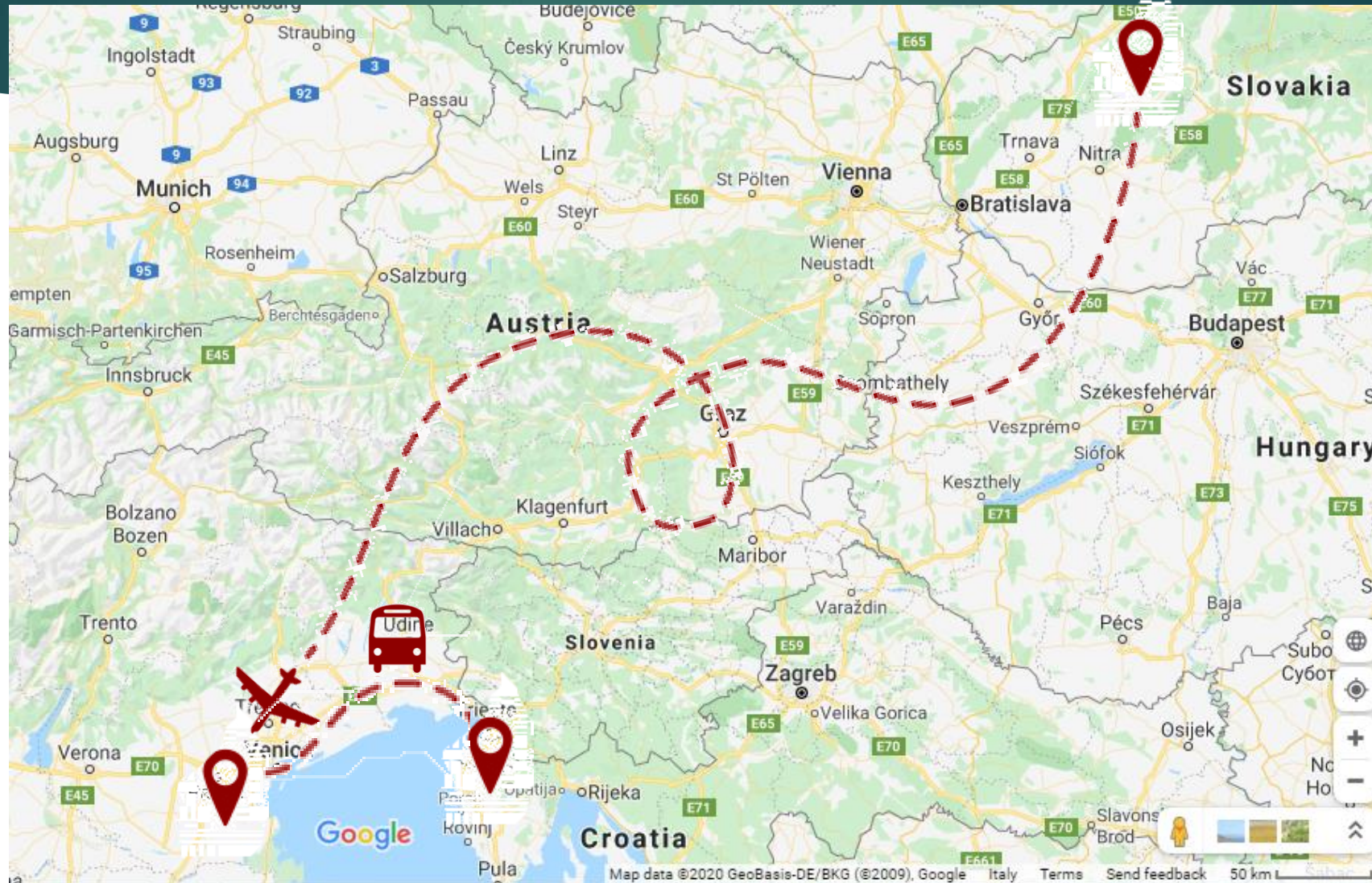

# TRIP TO CONSELVE: February 11-16 2019



In February 2019 Erasmus+ twinning week with the foreign colleagues of the partner schools from Domaniza, Slovakia and Buie, Croatia, took place. During their stay Erasmus+ staff, made up of eleven teachers of our institute, had a meeting for the management and implementation of the project and for a refresher course on the use of the platform e-Twinning.

The foreign teachers went into the selected classes to introduce their schools, to talk about the project and to do activities related to the topic planned.

They visited some secondary schools of 1st grade, some nursery schools and the I.I.S. "Enrico Mattei", in order to acquire knowledge of the Italian school system, from nursery schools to secondary schools of 2nd grade and to promote Erasmus+ in I.I.S. Mattei.

We visited the towns Conselve, Cartura and Monselice and admired the artistic heritage of the wonderful town of Padua.

Apart from institutional meetings with the members of the Municipality there were also convivial moments with teachers and the headmaster.

The collaboration of all the teachers and employees of the school was really precious.

- coordination work related to the implementation of the project: presentation of educational activities developed by the teachers of the respective schools; work phases

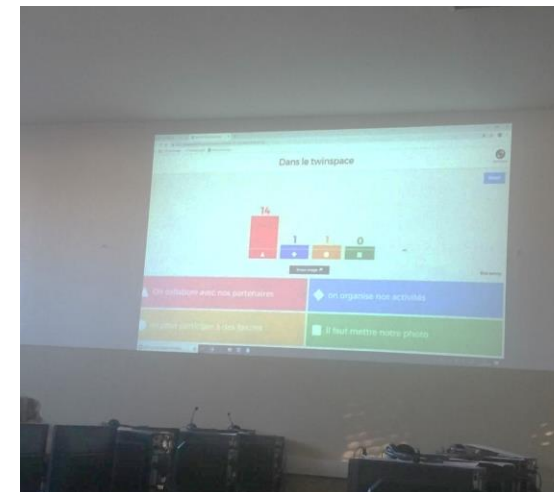


# TRIP TO CONSELVE

- **TEACHER TRAINING COURSE** for the use of teaching platforms and tools (e-Twinning, Google Form, Canva, Prezi).

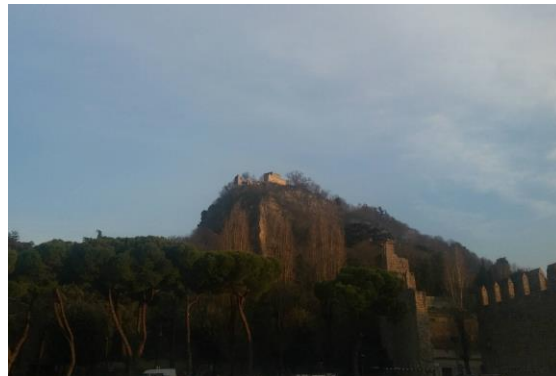


# TRIP TO CONSELVE

- sightseeing tour in Monselice during a traditional celebration day. Monselice is a medieval little town not far from Conselve.

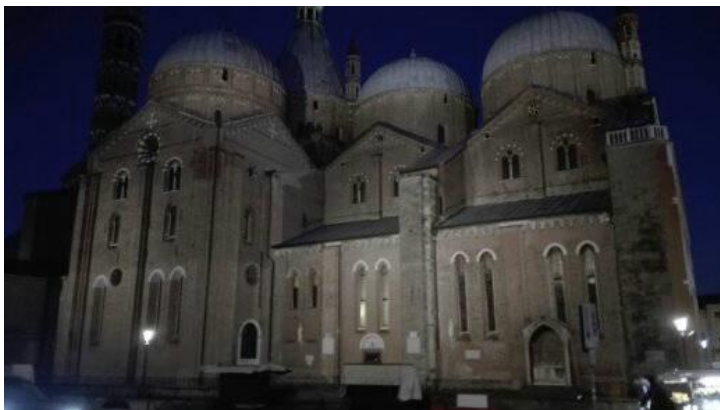


# TRIP TO CONSELVE

# TRIP TO MATTEI SCHOOL

## February 15 2019



Friday 15th February IIS Mattei received with enormous pleasure an Erasmus delegation made up of two Croatian and two Slovakian teachers; with them there was the Italian teacher Ms Veronica Del Pizzol of I.C. Tommaseo in Conselve.

After a short visit of the Institute guided by some students who represented the English and French courses the foreign teachers introduced the Erasmus Project (KA2 action) they are developing with I.C. Tommaseo: "Tradition and identity. Getting to know each other at the table". The close connection between cultural identity and cooking traditions of each country is the topic which will be developed within 24 months by the three institutes in Italy, Croatia and Slovakia through an e-twinning platform and through meetings between teachers and groups of 12 students from each country, with the final creation of a recipe padlet in English and French.

This meeting has been a real pleasure for both groups and it has given occasion to reintroduce Mattei Institute in a European dimension of learning and nationality.
